Дорогие друзья!

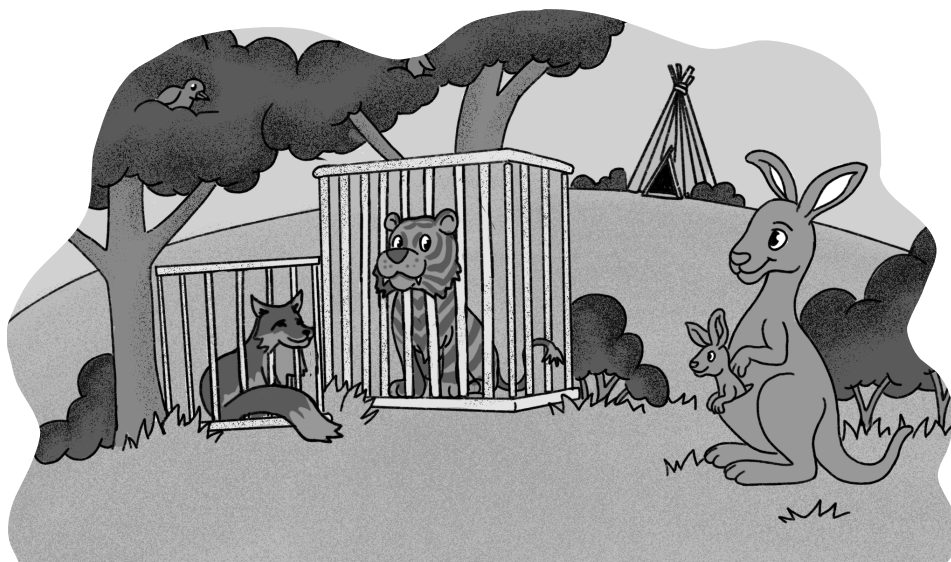
